#### A Parent's guide to ... tidying up

Tidying up is something young children should do .. it benefits your child's learning and development. Learning to tidy teaches children valuable life skills. It also helps you as parents! You can talk to your child about why its important to tidy up too, including risks of standing barefoot on those painful building blocks! Children of all ages can help, very young children can help putting toys away with adult help, for example passing an item to your child and asking them to put it in the box/cupboard, etc. You can turn tidying into a game too - for example how many toys can you put away, who can put the most away the quickest, putting items way that are a certain colour.
